The City of Eagan is hiring a Stormwater Technician to support the implementation of the City's Water Quality and Wetland Management and Stormwater Pollution Prevention Program (SWPPP). The position will have an emphasis on applying knowledge and experience of urban stormwater management for compliance with the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) programs to ensure entities comply with requirements and standards.

In this position you will:

- 1. Provide support for administrative requirements of Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) NPDES General Permits (coordinates applications, assessments, reports; maintains SWPPP documentation, keeps records, updates MS4 maps and inventories)**
- 2. Contribute to other programs such as SWPPP team, priority street sweeping, runoff metering, and winter salting best management practices (BMPs)**
- 3. Assist in the implementation of SWPPP six minimum control measures**
 - Execute public education and outreach programs about stormwater pollution prevention and relevant polices, regulations, and standards by delivering educational messages and supporting volunteer programs
 - Conduct public participation/involvement programs for SWPPP input by soliciting public input and providing access to documents and reports for review
 - Conduct illicit discharge (ID) detection and elimination programs (educate and train City staff to recognize and report illicit discharges, inspect high-risk areas where potential or historical pollution exists, investigate and respond to suspected/reported IDs, refer issues for corrective actions to eliminate IDs, and maintain city spill kits/materials and responds to spills as necessary)
 - Contribute to Construction Site Stormwater Runoff Control Programs by inspecting construction sites for compliance and referring issues for corrective actions to prevent stormwater pollution and resolutions of non-compliance
 - Contribute to Post-Construction Stormwater Management Programs by inspecting permanent, private stormwater BMPs for compliance and referring issues for corrective actions
 - Conduct Pollution Prevention/Good Housekeeping Programs (inspect municipal facilities, stockpiles, storage and material handling areas, municipal BMPs, MS4 ponds and outfalls; educate and train staff consistent with SWPPP related job duties)

Minimum Qualifications:

- High School Diploma or equivalent (G.E.D.) and College/Post-Secondary relevant coursework (water resources, natural resources, or physical sciences)
- **-OR-**
- Equivalent combination of relevant education and experience totaling at least two years
- Valid Driver's License

Desirable Qualifications:

- Associate's Degree or higher in Stormwater Management, Urban Watershed Studies, Water Resources, or a related field
- At least three years of experience with urban stormwater management

Working Hours and Conditions:

Monday-Friday, 7:30am-4:00pm with occasional hours before or after normal workdays and on weekends.

50% Office, 50% Field. Conditions may include variable weather extremes (heat, cold, rain, sleet, wind, snow) in uneven or rough terrains at various locations and construction sites. Must be able to lift, move, carry, push, pull, and retrieve objects of up to 50 pounds and from all levels up to 7-foot height.
